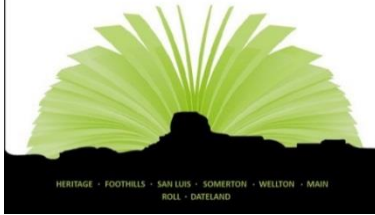

## **Coworking Oasis — Program Descriptions**

### **Meet-Up Monday – Entrepreneur Networking Meeting**

Come to the library and learn about the Coworking Oasis. Meet with a library staff member and ask questions. Find out where you are with your small business goals and see how we can help you get started on your idea for a business.

This networking and information session is a drop-in program for anyone interested in meeting others who want to start a small business. Exchange information, network, collaborate and create! The business librarian will be on hand for questions.

### **AWC – Small Business Development Center – Mentoring**

The AWC SBDC will be on site to provide face-to-face individual and small group evaluation and guidance by counselors with real life business ownership and management experience. If you have an idea and don't know where to start, mentoring assistance by the SBDC can help you fast-track your plans for startup and growth. Registration is not required.

### **Service Core of Retired Executives – Mentoring**

SCORE mentors deliver FREE and confidential advice for your business needs. Whether you are a startup or existing business, our mentors will help you achieve your goals. ### **Online Business Video Training**

Come and use the library's Coworking Oasis media center to watch online webinars, video training, and resources covering a variety of business topics. These tools offer an online learning portal for aspiring entrepreneurs and small business owners. Topics are chosen by attendees to each session. Q&A to Follow. The Library provides content and tools from a variety of online sources and database subscription services for training.

### **Entrepreneurship Outreach Network (ASU) Startup School**

The Entrepreneurship Outreach Network collaborates with libraries to promote local innovation and entrepreneurship. The Arizona State University Startup School is a series of facilitated workshops where entrepreneurs learn lean startup methods in order to develop a successful business. ASU Startup School workshops are delivered in a sequence of continuing education modules, organized in three stages:

- Stage 1: Ideation – Learning modules/workshops for entrepreneurs that refine initial problems/solutions and help to learn how to navigate viable markets.
- Stage 2: Validation – Learning modules/workshops for entrepreneurs focused on experimenting and developing prototypes, minimum viable products, and launching solutions in the market.
- Stage 3: Acceleration – Learning modules/workshops for entrepreneurs that have successfully demonstrated product-market fit and revenue generation and are ready to scale, expand, and grow.

### **Featured Presentations**
