### Stargazing:

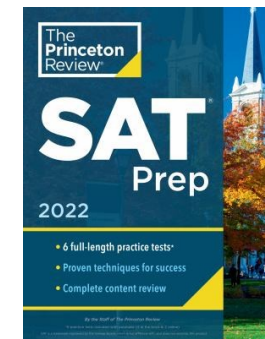
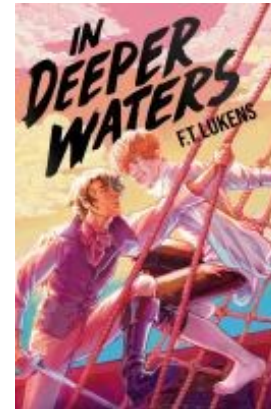
