Eventos bilingües o en Español:

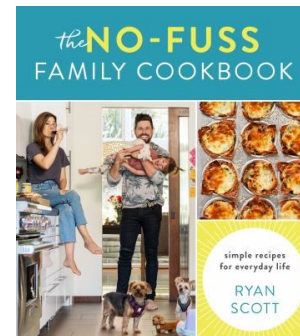
Cafecito Chat:
